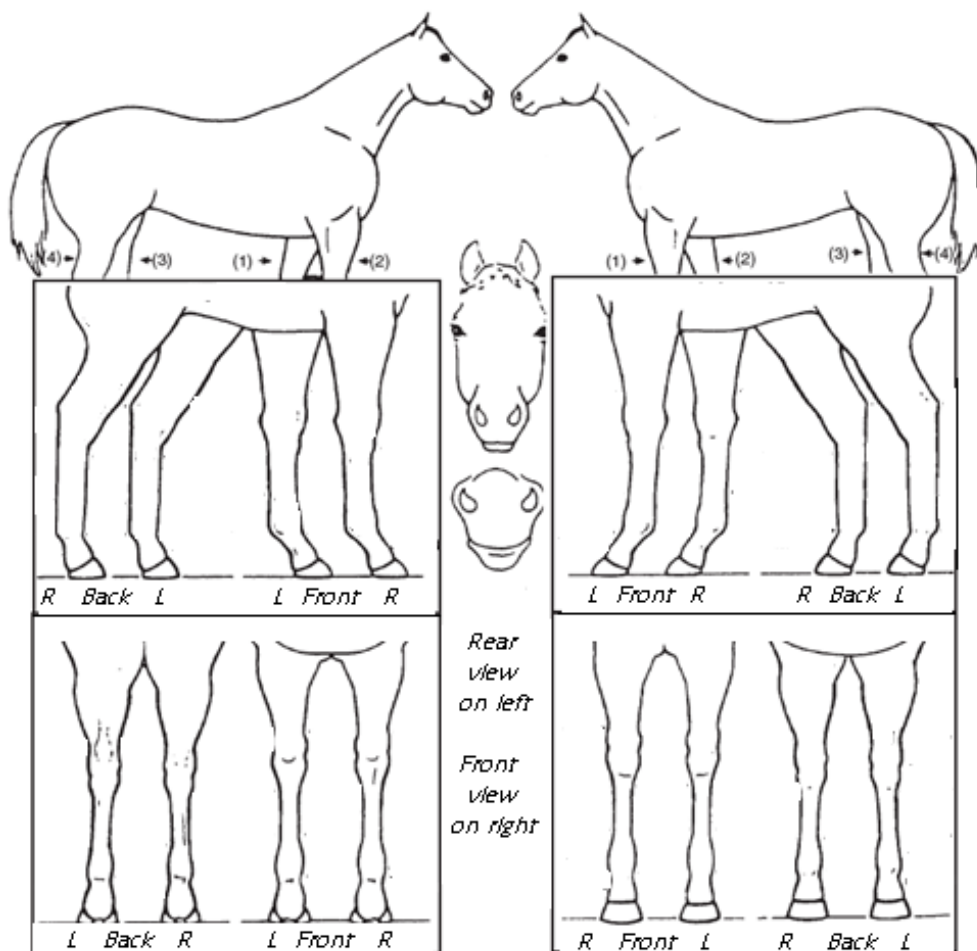

Grade 3 or higher are not eligible to ride.</i>	<i>Score pre ride</i>	Grade 1: Difficult to observe – Deduct 20 pts Not consistently apparent regardless of circumstances (i.e. weight carrying, circling, inclines, hard surfaces, etc). Grade 2: Difficult to observe at walk or trot in straight line – deduct 40 pts Consistently apparent under certain conditions (i.e. weight carrying, circling, inclines, hard surfaces, etc) Grade 3: Consistently observable at a trot under all circumstances. Grade 4: Obvious lameness. Marked nodding, hitching or shortened stride.
